



WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

- The Bridges Program is open to students from underrepresented groups who are United States citizens or permanent residents. Individuals from underrepresented groups include:
 - ✓ Individuals from racial and ethnic groups that have been shown to be underrepresented in health-related sciences on a national basis. The following racial groups have been shown to be underrepresented in biomedical research: American Indians or Alaska Natives, Blacks or African Americans, Hispanics or Latinos, Native Hawaiians or Other Pacific Islanders.

- ✓ Individuals who come from a family with annual income below established low-income thresholds.
- First year undergraduate students in the associate degree programs in LAS, LAA, Chemical Technology, Unclassified (UC) or Unclassified Health (UCH).
- Students who have a strong interest in a career in biomedical or behavioral sciences
- Students who started their undergraduate careers at City Tech
- 12-30 credits completed at the time of acceptance into the program
- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Full-time students
