



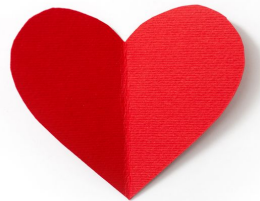

Transferring to Brooklyn College

Fall 2019 & Spring 2020

- Application Deadlines : **February 1st** & September 15th 2019
Otherwise, Direct Admits Process (in person)
No Application Fee to pay
- GPA: 2.2 or above
- No “HOLD” from the Bursar’s Office



After ~ 2 months (April & mid-October)

1. Letter of Acceptance (received by mail and email)
2. Return Commitment Form with \$100 deposit
3. Make a SMART (Self-Managed Appointment Registration Tool) Appointment to register for classes
